- Be registered, in good standing, at an Ontario faculty of law and studying for an LL.B, J.D. or LL.M.; and
- Have a record of dedication to advancing equality rights (such as, but not limited to religion, gender, sexual orientation, gender identity, disability, mental health, refugee, aboriginal, minority and HIV/AIDS victim's rights).

The following is a non-exhaustive list of examples of relevant experience:

- advocacy;
- volunteer work at a clinic, non-profit organization, government office, or within the law school community;
- academic endeavors such as journals, articles, papers, research projects; and
- community outreach programs.

The recipient will be invited, as a guest of honour, to the WLAO President's Awards Gala on May 18, 2023. Applicants must submit a letter of merit (not exceeding two pages) detailing their dedication to advancing equality rights. Where possible, provide supporting documentation about your activities (e.g.: publications in academic journals, letters of recommendation, *curriculum vitae*).
